**Ezra Rosenberg**

Ezra Rosenberg supervises the Lawyers' Committee's national voting rights litigation. He joined the Lawyers' Committee in November 2014, continuing a 40-year career in the public and private sectors. Previously, Rosenberg was a partner at Dechert LLP's Princeton office, where he was ranked among the top litigators both in New Jersey and nationwide by numerous publications and was named one of the top 500 lawyers in the nation by *Lawdragon*.

At Dechert, Rosenberg was actively involved in *pro bono* representations, including successfully challenging Texas's photo ID voting law; supervising advantageous settlements of a minority profiling case and a prison conditions case in New Jersey; and successfully challenging the admissibility of a defendant's rap lyrics in his attempted murder trial. In 2014, Rosenberg was named to *The National Law Journal's* "Pro Bono Hot List" for his role in significant public interest cases. Rosenberg is one of the lead trial counsel in the case challenging the Secretary of Commerce's decision to add a citizenship question to the 2020 Census.
