Jeff Greenberg is a Senior Economist and Executive Director at J.P. Morgan Global Wealth Management in New York, where he conducts macroeconomic analysis and identifies trends in financial markets. He is a member of the Private Bank's Capital Markets Investment Group and the Global Markets Council. His research informs tactical trade ideas and his strategic views influence how client portfolios are positioned. Jeff's areas of expertise include monetary policy, currencies, inflation, real estate, and international trade.

He first joined J.P. Morgan in 2012 and rejoined in 2017, following two years with UBS Securities. As a Macro Strategist at UBS, he was responsible for conducting thematic macro research on G10 economies and generating FX and interest rate trade recommendations. Jeff began his Wall Street career as a US Economist for Nomura Securities, where he provided economic analysis for the firm's trading desks and institutional clients. He previously conducted research at the Federal Reserve Banks of New York and Boston, a Chinese investment bank, the Carnegie Council for Ethics in International Affairs, and National Public Radio.

Jeff's economic views have been featured by major news organizations, including *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Financial Times*, *CNBC*, *Bloomberg*, *CheddarTV*, and *Reuters*.

Jeff earned a master's in international economics from Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs and a B.A. from Tufts University. He grew up in Ellwood City, Pennsylvania, and attended Mercersburg Academy, where he began studying Chinese language. He studied abroad at the Harbin Institute of Technology and speaks Mandarin.
