
Government, policy makers, businesses, human services, education, arts, and philanthropy can use demographics:

## We need better answers to pressing questions


- 1. Who leads and works at nonprofits?
- 2. Who is served by nonprofit organizations?
- 3. How are grants focused/targeted (or not)?
- 4. Which organizations are supported by philanthropy (or not)?



# There must be a better way...

On the one hand, 76% of foundation leaders said they are changing reporting requirements to reduce the burden on grantees.

On the other hand, 40% of foundation leaders said they are increasing their demographic data collection.













Increasingly, funders are finding themselves in an information ecosystem that is challenging them to align on common practices rather than rely on bespoke systems. Our partners at the Technology Association of Grantmakers conducted some groundbreaking research that asserts what we already suspected: Nearly 40 percent

## Demographics via Candid

National campaign to capture demographic data on the Candid profile in a standard, reusable format

- Builds on what already exists: Candid profile
- Nonprofits share demographic data, one time, in a standardized format
- Demographic data will be made freely available through multiple channels



## Benefits to the sector

Aggregate data to inform full view of equity across the sector.

Tool to benchmark organizations, identify gaps, and track progress.

Way to find nonprofits reflective of communities they serve. Enables nonprofits to share data just one time.





## Candid profiles


- Candid profiles help nonprofit organizations **amplify your stories for free** to Candid's vast audience of foundations and donors—12 million visitors a year and growing

## Collect demographic information

- Use <u>How to collect and share</u> demographic data guide
- Specifically:
  - Ask don't guess
  - Say it's for the public profile
  - Make clear it's voluntary:
    - Decline to state
    - We do not collect

## How to collect and share demographic data

Candid and Demographics via Candid partners invite you to share your organization's demographics through your nonprofit profile. Doing so shows your organization's commitment to equity, can help funders find your organization, and strengthens the sector with insights based on data.

To help you get started, Candid and CHANGE Philanthropy created this guide, including:

- · A sample survey-taking the guesswork out of how to ask these questions
- · Best practices and definitions

#### Demographic survey best practices

- Don't guess, always ask
- · Make all parts of the survey voluntary
- . Include a "Decline to state" option for each question
- · Treat with sensitivity and confidentiality
- Collect and share on the profile annually



#### Survey administration

#### Participants

To fully complete your Candid profile demographic questions, you should administer the survey to your:

- CEO/Leader
- Senior staff (defined as C-suite or management with budgetary oversight)
- Staff
- Board members

Include information about the people you consider to be your staff-full-time and part-time.

#### Reporting

When you aggregate and report the results, note:

- Information for senior staff should include the CEO
- · Information for staff should include CEO and senior staff
- If you do not get a response, you should categorize it as "Unknown"


