How To Become A Client

STEP ONE: Look online at www.probonopartner.org to see if your organization is eligible for services and, if so, submit a Request for Legal Assistance.

STEP TWO: A Pro Bono Partnership staff attorney will set up a screening meeting (with preferably two board members from your organization) to determine whether your organization is eligible and to identify any outstanding legal needs.

STEP THREE: If your nonprofit qualifies, we will connect your organization with a Pro Bono Partnership staff attorney or volunteer attorneys from law firms or corporations who can help you with your legal matters.
