### City Interventions and Existing Funds

**Community COVID-19 Fund –** This fund will follow FEMA's four stages of emergency management: preparedness, response, mitigation, and recovery. Its funding focus areas are individual relief, public health needs, non-profit/social service relief, and long-term recovery needs.

**Lead Agency –** United Way of Greater Newark

**Small Business Fund** — The fund is open to small businesses that have experienced loss of income as a result of COVID-19. Grants are available of up to \$10,000 per business.

**Lead Agency –** United Way of Greater Newark

Creative Catalyst Fund – The Create Catalyst Fund will support the local community of artists as well as small to-midsize arts and cultural organizations. Grants of \$2,500 to \$25,000 are available

Lead Agency – Newark Arts

Non-Profit Fund – The City of Newark pledged \$1 million in support to non-profits. Details are forthcoming.
