

The Full Service Community School Health Centers are part of the Full Service Community Schools initiative. These comprehensive school-based pediatric health clinics provide students with access to excellent quality healthcare during school hours at five school locations. These participating schools offer Board Certified Pediatricians for sick and well care including immunizations, eye care: exams and glasses, dental education and services, nutrition education and workshops, and individual behavioral health counseling and group therapy sessions. The Health Centers began four years ago in school 5. By year 2 it began to develop in the New Roberto Clemente School followed by the Napier Academy in year 3 as well as School 6. This year, January 2015, we opened our 5th location in school 15. Below is the approximate total number of students enrolled in the five Health Center since their perspective school openings:

Total students: 720

Pediatric physician: 217

Dental: 482

Optical: 476

Nutrition: 125

Parent nutrition talks and health education workshops: 249

Behavioral Health: 185

- Please note that the Health Centers participate in 4 of the 5 schools with a behavioral health counseling program.
- Please note this year, we also worked with the Helen Keller Foundation as a pilot and screened 524 students at the New Roberto Clemente and 168 students received eye glasses in addition to the other students registered in the Health Center at NRC.
